




Each student will be nurtured with their individual technical and artistic strengths and weaknesses identified and catered for by a dedicated team of professionals who all share the same vision.



With an average cohort size of just 22 students across all years, our approach to professional training is truly different. No other institution offers this level of personalised attention.

The unique size of our college translates directly into exceptional performance opportunities for our students. Our showcases feature around 30 dance and musical theatre pieces and we ensure every student is fully integrated into our productions participating in at least 13-14 pieces with up to 15 different costume changes across a range of styles.

The choreography is designed not only to challenge them but also to reinforce and apply the skills they've developed in the studio.

Additionally, students have further performance opportunities throughout the academic year.

This guarantees they are not only featured but also gain exposure in diverse roles and settings.

Unmatched Contact Hours and Faculty Expertise

At Morea, we believe in the value of meaningful investment in our students. Our faculty includes:

- 2 Ballet instructors
- 3 Jazz teachers
- 2 Contemporary teachers
- 3 Tap teachers

With over 40 contact hours per week in small group settings, our student-to-teacher ratio ensures personalised attention and intensive learning. Through the ISTD DDE qualifications, our graduates are equipped with the tools to build a stable career as educators and can immediately generate income after graduation.

Our students train with ISTD syllabus creators, senior examiners, and international lecturers, giving them direct access to the highest level of expertise.

Our approach to showcasing our students reflects the core values of the college. Our shows are designed to provide all students with opportunities to learn and apply their skills, not just a select few.



Teaching Qualification

ISTD DDE Diploma in Dance Education

The DDE is an Ofqual regulated teaching qualification, which provides an excellent induction to a career in teaching dance. It offers student teachers a clear pathway to becoming a qualified dance teacher with the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing and allows the opportunity to engage with up-to-date research in best practices related to dance teaching and learning. The DDE forms part of the Society's regulated teaching qualifications portfolio and at Morea Performing Arts is available to residents in the UK and Europe for the Theatre Dance genres including Imperial Classical Ballet, Modern Theatre, and Tap Dance.

Overview

It consists of 5 individual units that are written to support the learning from one unit to another preparing the student fully for teaching in the studio.

- Unit 1: Preparing for Safe Teaching Practice
- Unit 2: Observing, Assisting and Teaching Practice
- Unit 3: Vocational Graded Examination in Dance: Intermediate
- Unit 4: Dance Practice
- Unit 5: Child development

Morea Performing Arts is an ISTD Approved Dance Centre (ADC). As an Approved Centre we go through a rigorous approval process with the Society to ensure we have the solid policies and procedures in place to deliver high quality teaching qualifications to our students.

Successful completion of the Diploma in Dance Education will mean you are able to apply for Full Membership of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dancing. This will enable you to open your dance school ANYWHERE in the world!. This also entitles you to enter students for examinations and benefit from the ISTD's full membership package.

The next step for your teaching journey is to consider the higher teaching qualifications up to the potential opportunity to become an ISTD Fellow, Tutor and Examiner.

Katie trained at the London Contemporary Dance School and the Alvin Ailey School, NYC.

Katie has taught at Elmhurst Ballet School, the London College of Dance and Bird College; this included teaching Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Contemporary and Choreography, as well as being Head of Contemporary and Composition and creator and Dance Director of the Bird Theatre Company (Bird College).

Having worked closely with Miss Doreen Bird and Sue Passmore (who encouraged Katie's choreographic abilities), she is an international examiner and lecturer for the ISTD Modern and Tap faculties. 




Students must be aged 15 or over and successfully complete an audition process.
